## Round Pavilion Set-Up Instructions

### Addendum for Stalwart Round Pavilion

#### **Preparation**

Line 5-3 & 5-4. The set-up lines attach to the edge of the roof, not over the top spike. This allows them to also act as high-wind lines.

#### **Raising the Roof**

Line 4-1. This line is giving you a special trick for getting the first spoke in which can be tricky when the roof canvas is all hanging down. However, the set-up lines on a Stalwart hold the roof out, making it much easier to get the first spoke in, so don't sweat it.

Line 5-Note. The set-up lines on a Stalwart won't let it spin, so ignore this trick.

#### **Hanging the Walls**

This section is pretty much unchanged, but... Because the set-up lines hold the roof out, it is possible to hang the walls before putting in the spokes. This may be easier to do in this order, since the roof is lower without the spokes in. Your mileage may vary. Try both ways and go with what works better for you.
